Our local District RYLA course is held at The Dean Field Studies Centre, in The Forest of Dean, at Parkend, Lydney. The center offers a wide range of activities and provides comfortable accommodation, lecture and common rooms and full catering facilities.

Activities will include canoeing, climbing, caving, a rope course, abseiling and orienteering. These physical activities are backed up by theory so that each RYLA participant develops his or her's leadership and communication skills. You will set your own objectives and your progress will be reviewed throughout the course,
